

Directions On How To Write in A Journalistic Tone

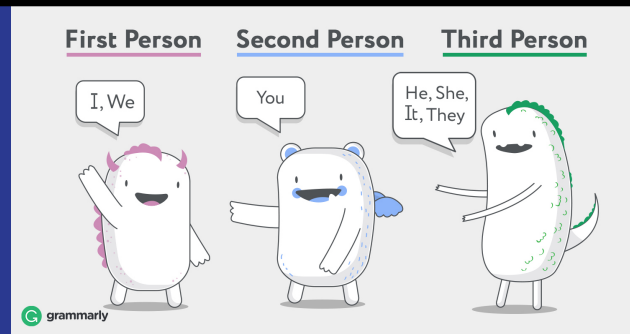
