

Writing with a Journalistic

WHEN WRITING AS A JOURNALIST AND CREATING AN ARTICLE, A JOURNALISTIC TONE IS OF MUCH USE AND IMPORTANCE TO WRITE AN INFORMATIVE ARTICLE RATHER THAN AN EMOTIONAL AND OPINIONATED ARTICLE THAT OTHERS COULD DISAGREE OR AGREE WITH.

- 1. Don't use words that are 1st person such as I, we, my, or my. Use a third person perspective only using words like he, she, him, and her, avoiding the usage of personal words.
- 2. Use first person words in quotes only.
- 3. Focus the writing on facts, not feelings.
